Commissioners held a conference call with Greg Bockrath to discuss the question of the compensation of landowners for the easement. The compensation would have to come from the project total since the grant nor the sewer district cannot pay it outright. The Commissioners would like Bockrath & Assoc. to contact the homeowners on behalf of the Commissioners and emphasize that all the landowners (his neighbors) would be paying that easement. Greg suggested instead of compensation they would get private drainage added for their property. Greg also said the legal descriptions need to be competed also.
