Jack said since the Council meeting are half staffed they do not have a full council at a meetings the decision has been delayed. Hopefully in May they will have a full council meeting. The EPA is delaying the licensure requirements for the year due to the COVID 19. The Commissioners need to repair the pump station either way so they want to do it according to the Village requirements so it does not have to be redone again for the Village to eventually take it over. The Commissioners do not want to be in the Water/Sewer business. The Village is ok with the plans thus far so the repairs can proceed prior to the maintenance agreement being accepted.

Commissioners Schroeder, Schlumbohm and Lammers discussed the sewer pump plans submitted by Kahle Electric. No Discussion.
