Commissioners Schroeder, Schlumbohm and Lammers held a conference call with Norm from Apex Equipment regarding the new baler for recycling. Commissioner Schroeder asked about the warranty and preventative maintenance for the new equipment. Apex did not have preventative maintenance included in the quote. The Commissioners are asking that it be included with the bid. Norm will redo the bid and submit again.

Tim Schnipke met with Commissioners Schroeder, Schlumbohm and Lammers to give an update the a/c units are going in at Third St. There was a wet spot in the reception area ceiling of the Health Dept. Tim presented pictures and quotes for repairing the ceiling. Tim also said tires will be needed on his truck and a few of the mowers. He presented quotes for the tires. Tim said the recycling bins were cleaned up behind the Ag Complex and the roof is done. The Engineer may be moving and Tim said he could move to the current front County Garage building if needed. If that happens, he said they would need the whole building. The request of the mechanic for the EMS was discussed and Tim said he is not willing to share space or tools for a mechanic. They are not equipped with a lift or oil rack for doing car repairs. The courthouse a/c was discussed there are no new issues. They are still waiting on one coil for the system. The system is online and they can monitor online. Tim said we should start to see an energy savings, since the system does not have to run all weekend and shuts down each night. The new Jail kitchen unit is not in yet, the jail unit is in they are waiting on favorable weather to

change it over. Hoping to get it done before it dies completely. The drainage for the recycling area was discussed.

The business agenda was held with Commissioners Schroeder, Schlumbohm and Lammers and Cindy Landwehr, Clerk.

The minutes from Tuesday August 9, 2022 were reviewed and approved.

Commissioners Schroeder, Schlumbohm and Lammers and Engineer Mike Lenhart held a bid opening for Road 18-S Bridge replacement. Construction estimate was \$ 627,000.00. The bids were received as:

Dawn Coleman & Pat Loper of Bowser-Morner met with Commissioners and Alaina Siefker via Zoom regarding the Landfill TSS and the Explosive Gas Monitoring Plan. Pat has been working on some ideas for correcting the TSS issues. He came up with a plan of putting in a smaller pond in the big pond using clean hard fill, putting a dike in it and covering the sides. Dawn at Bowser did a sample at the bottom of the cap to see what that is picking up for TSS to compare. It is very little. Commissioner Schlumbohm asked if a pipe from the hill and going straight to the creek from there would work. Pat said that actually would probably work to eliminate outfall on the big pond and cut a channel to the little pond. He said this would be considered a modification to our NPDES permit and that would require EPA permission also. Commissioner Lammers asked what that would cost. Pat said a mod to the permit may cost possibly around \$2-3,000 but would be much less than his original plan. They would also do the pipe drop inlet with a skimmer. The commissioners asked Bowser-Morner to prepare a proposal to get a license modified and come up with drawings for John's idea. They will work on it. Dawn brought up the Explosive Gas monitoring plan that they prepared for the new changes EPA added. EPA sent a notice of deficiency on it. Most items were minor that they were working on. The one that is more important, is that the EPA thinks more probes (5-6 of them) need to be put in since it was done and approved when the landfill closed. They said 2 are not deep enough on south side and want 2 more installed on that side, 1 by the maintenance building and 3 on the Northern boundary. Dawn said she wants to talk to EPA about them to try to eliminate all except by the maintenance building, that one she doesn't think we can get out of. She wanted the Commissioners permission to talk to EPA about it. The commissioners said that is ok to

ask. She is also going to see what kind of time frame we are looking at. The notice did not state a time frame. She will get back to us on those items as well.

Mr. Lammers moved to adjourn for the day.
