Mr. Schlumbohm called the meeting to order with Mr. Schroeder and Mr. Lammers via teleconference by reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

Commissioners Schroeder, Schlumbohm and Lammers discussed an email that was received from Bill Morris regarding a ditching project that was done privately and tapped in to a catch basin on a public tile on the Wm Foulkes Dt. without proper notice to the Trustees or County Engineer. And it will create additional water issues for the rest of the property owners in the watershed. The Commissioners will talk to Mike Lenhart and will have to view the project.

Tim Schnipke met with Commissioners Schroeder, Schlumbohm and Lammers via teleconference to discuss equipment. Tim presented a quote for the tractor with a trade in it would be approx. \$20,000. The loader and mower would be traded with the tractor. The new tractor would have a cab and remote hydraulics. It would have a higher loader which is beneficial for loading salt. It would not be used to mow. With state bid we are saving about \$6,000. Tim said they are still shopping for trailers. They are looking at tilt trailers also. Tim also presented quotes for new toilets in the women's restroom on the first floor. The men's room will also need the toilets replaced. The plumbing to the restrooms is old and does need an upgrade. Vince said he got a complaint about the tree at O-G Road complex that is near the parking area that leaves dirty residue on cars. It is not near a building there is a drainage tile near it. A pedestrian way for wheel chairs to Board of Elections was discussed. Sewer Dist #2 the valves are being replaced and the last few pieces of the vent need to be installed. The walls at Home Health will be started next week.

The business agenda was held with Commissioners Schroeder, Schlumbohm and Lammers via teleconference and Cindy Landwehr, Clerk.

Ryan Moran and Mike Lenhart met with Commissioners Schroeder, Schlumbohm and Lammers via teleconference to review the Wm. Foulkes ditch project. Permission is not needed to tile your own field. Foulkes tried to get the tile outlet replaced through the petition process and it was dismissed. The trustees put in a new catch basin along the east and west sides of the road along with a new road tile. Mr. Foulkes did not tap in to the catch basin he tapped before the catch basin on his own property. Mr. Foulkes water would go into that catch basin anyway. So the complaint by Mr. Morris is not entirely accurate. Mr. Lenhart is looking to move the whole ditch to the east side of Rd 16-S which would eliminate two bridges that are in need of improvements also. Mr. Morris is also contacting the Sugar Creek Trustees about this matter. Mr. Lenhart also talked to Jeff Giesige and Mr. Foulkes about these drainage issues. Mr. Foulkes has offered to put drainage in on Morris's land that he would pay for. Mr. Morris and Mr. Foulkes have not communicated with each other. The past ditch records will be reviewed for all the inlet tiles that come into the ditch. The Commissioners were trying to recollect the decision process for this petition request. The trustees were planning to replace the road catch basins at the time as well as the Engineer trying to lay over the open ditch along Rd 16-S. And the other surrounding landowners did not want to pay for it. The minutes from the hearing were reviewed. Commissioner Lammers suggested that Mr. Lenhart contact Mr. Collar to gain right of way for

the ditch layover. The layover may not help all the landowners but it may help some of the drainage issues for Mr. Morris.

The minutes from Tuesday December 1, 2020 were reviewed and approved.

Bob Benroth stopped in to review 2021 budget figures with Commissioners Schroeder, Schlumbohm and Lammers.

Mr. Schlumbohm moved to adjourn for the day.
