The business agenda was held with Commissioners Schroeder and Lammers and Cindy Landwehr, Clerk.

Commissioners Schroeder and Lammers attended a Zoom meeting with Allen, Hardin, Seneca, Wyandot, and Hancock regarding the Blanchard River Stream Enhancement. A review of the river was done in regard to log jams. Photos of the logjams were shared. The logjams are classified by size. A, B & C.

A= 1-3 logs, B= 4-6 logs, C= 7-9 logs, C+ =10 or more logs

Also discussed were leaners, trees leaning over the river that should be cut. Starting at Route 30 and following the river the logjams were identified into Putnam County. Hancock Co. EMA provided the video of the river. Sept 26- through Nov the logjam numbers 317 Class A, 43 Class B, 31 Class C, 10 Class C+. There are many leaners also. The numbers this year are a bit higher than other years. The work to remove these would take about 3-3 1/2 months to complete. There are power tools that will be used saws, log splitters and chains for dragging.
