Commissioners Schroeder, Schlumbohm and Lammers met with Jim Skora of GT Environmental along with Alaina & Ashley Siefker to discuss the Solid Waste Plan Update. Says ours has to be updated every 5 years. Jim said our first draft is due May 2021 with a public process in Sept 2022. Starting date is set as 2-29-2020 with 2019 numbers being the reference year. Jim said they still are letting districts use the old format 3.0 as of now. Eventually the EPA wants everyone to be on the new one format 4.0. As long as we start work on February 29, 2020 and they don't do away with the old format 3.0 before that date, we will be ok to do ours on the old format yet. Jim said about \$35,000 would be a guess for him but would be willing to put a proposal together. He said they could do all of it or could even share some of it. He said besides the ADR numbers, we will need to know the Haulers and Open Dump Sites in the County. If we don't get a plan submitted by the very last date, by law the EPA will write a plan for us and that they will push the district to do more. The commissioners asked him to do a proposal for us.

Commissioners Schroeder, Lammers & Schlumbohm went out to the Recycling Complex to view the magnet for the metal recycling.
