A test of the generator will be done tomorrow. Tim is thinking the faulty part is the cause of it not working properly. The generator is three phase already but the one leg is the problem where it does not always kick in when it should. They will test tomorrow to figure which leg is not starting. The courthouse needs 600-800 amps to run the whole building including air chiller.

Tim also brought up a dehumidifying issue at the jail with the air conditioning. It is not moving enough air and smells and moisture are building up. Tim said they cleaned the maintenance shop.
