Mr. Schroeder, Lammers and Schlumbohm met with Kevin Wilson the new Fairgrounds secretary. He wanted to introduce himself and meet the commissioners. Mr. Wilson said he is looking forward to working with the Commissioners. He is a retired teacher who is originally from Continental. Mr. Wilson is training with Linda and learning the operations side of the Fair. Mr. Wilson also has a CDL and the Commissioners asked if he would be interested in helping out with Recycling also.

The minutes from Thursday, October 1, 2020 were reviewed and approved.

The process of the e-citations was explained to reduce the contact with others with the information being transmitted electronically. Cost the will be \$5000 per year with a cost savings in the paper processing the software will need to be purchased for approx. \$42,000. Most Villages and officers are on board with the new process. And it was questioned if the CARES money could pay for the software. The Commissioners are in agreement to have the CARES funding pay for the initial purchase of the software directly with no reimbursement needed. Officer Brecht joined the meeting. The delivery on the purchase must be done before 12/30/2020 to qualify for the CARES funding. Most of the installation could be done remotely so there should not be a wait. A purchase order will be written up for the purchase directly from the CARES funding. Bob stated another disbursement was received by the County for the CARES funding. Bob advised the Commissioners not to encourage any more expenses from the County, as of now all the funding is accounted for. The Auditor will forward the list of expenses to submit for reimbursement to the County of the CARES funds. A resolution will be drawn up listing the expenses for the Commissioners' to approve. The Commissioners were informed that the funds advanced to the EMA must be

reimbursed to the County also. The purchase order for the business grants can be done also to have the funds appropriated.
