Joe Hohlbein met with Commissioners Schroeder and Schlumbohm regarding Soil & Water's request regarding the school recycling grant. The commissioners asked if there are any pieces of equipment or anything needed that can go on with the school grant. Joe said eventually a skid loader to replace the old one. They told Joe to get a quote for that. He said he also needs new tires and they told him to get some prices on smooth tires. We would probably make more money selling the old one out right and the claw bucket should be able to be used on new one. Inside building everything should be good. He said the bin on the new baler and the sorting table works for now. The commissioners would like to see the bins for the schools do 1/3 paper and 2/3 cardboard. Will need locks for the bins so the public don't get into them. Bonnie & Sarah are getting the #s for the totes for the classrooms and how many 95 yard bins will be needed. Right now Joe does Leipsic about 4x a year. He does Ottoville with his livestock trailer picking up their glass, plastic, metal & paper to our recycling. Kalida School brings their stuff to Ottawa. Everyone agreed just start out with paper & cardboard for now. John said to check with our grant writer on possibly doing the grant for us again. Alaina printed off the recycling totals and bale tracker spreadsheets for everyone to look at the tons and pricing of the different products.

The business agenda was held with Commissioners Schroeder and Schlumbohm and Cindy Landwehr, Clerk.

The minutes from Tuesday, October 1, 2024 were reviewed and approved.

Mike Lenhart informed the Commissioners that Joe Karhoff was traveling across the closed Road M-6 bridge and had damage to their side-by-side vehicle due to the barriers being too close together. The bridge is closed for regular traffic. The barrier blocks were set at 5 feet at the time they were set and will be reviewed to make sure they have not been moved and place them properly. The closed bridge on Road 18-A will be checked also. The Road O bridge replacement may be done by the end of October, weather permitting. The Road M-6 bridge is a unique bridge due to it's historicalness there is no other bridge like it in the country, which is why it qualified for the historical restoration grant. And it was restored not reinforced for current day traffic.
