The quotes for the door controls at the Sheriff's office are being reviewed and see if that cost can be split between this year and next year.

The neighbor to the east was concerned about the proximity of the new property line to her house. Typically, the alley would be divided 50/50 when it is vacated. There are trees in the area in question. The alley is currently a 12 ft width. Mrs. Zendejas would like to know if she is getting 6 ft. from the alley. She does maintain the area in question. They do not know all the plans of those who made the request if they will be installing a fence.
