RESOLVED, That Mr. Michael Lenhart, Putnam County Engineer, is hereby authorized to employ labor and proceed by force account in the maintenance, repair and construction of roads, bridges and culverts in Putnam County during the year 2026.

and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Putnam County Commissioners reserve unto themselves the right and authority to make all purchases of material and equipment required in the maintenance, repair or construction of roads, bridges, culverts in Putnam County during the year 2026, except that the Board may from time to time by resolution delegate such purchase authority to Mr. Lenhart, Putnam County Engineer.

WHEREAS, the Ohio revised Code Section 153.64, 4931 and 4933 provides to the Board of County Commissioners, the authority to control the installation and placement of any public utilities within the dedicated public right of ways of all County maintained highways; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners believe there will be more expansion of the broadband network and new facilities and to allow for a more efficient deployment of broadband infrastructure throughout the county to authorize the Engineer to issue those permits, and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Revised Code Section 5589 and 5543 provides to the Board of County Commissioners, the authority to control any digging and excavating on or along a County

maintained highway and for the placement of a private driveway approach to a County maintained highway; and

WHEREAS, The Ohio revised Code Section 4513.34 provides to the Board of County Commissioners, the authority to permit oversize and overweight vehicles using County maintained highways. And

THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Putnam County Commissioner does hereby authorize the Putnam County Engineer to develop and administer permits for the above described activities including broadband within the County road right-of-ways and to keep said permits with the permanent road records of Putnam County.

This service contract is made and entered into this 2nd day of January, 2026, by and between the Putnam County Commissioners and Deb Mansfield, (hereinafter referred to as "Independent Contractor").

Whereas, The Putnam County Commissioners are desirous of retaining the services of Independent Contractor to train new employee to clean buildings occupied by Putnam County entities.

Now therefore, in consideration of mutual promises and covenants contained in this contract, the parties agree as follows:

1. SERVICES

Independent Contractor shall work and provide training for cleaning services. Independent Contractor agrees to track her hours of work under the within contract and shall provide the Putnam County Commissioners with a time sheet of the same.

2. COMPENSATION

The Putnam County Commissioners, upon receipt of her hourly time sheet, shall pay the Independent Contractor for services rendered herein a rate of \$25.00 (twenty-five dollars and 00 cents) per hour for a maximum term of 40 hours per week.

3. TERM

The term of this contract commences on January 2, 2026 and continues thereafter up and until the contract is terminated by either party upon 10 days notice.

4. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

Independent Contractor agrees to indemnify and hold the Putnam County Commissioners harmless against any loss, liability or expense arising out of or in connection with the negligent and willful acts or omissions of Independent Contractor arising out of this agreement.

5. INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR

It is mutually understood and agreed that the relationship between the parties is that of Independent Contractors. Neither party is the agent, employee or servant of the other. Independent Contractor also agrees under the terms of this contract, that she is not eligible for workers compensation or unemployment benefits, Putnam County employee fringe benefits such as health insurance, PERS, vacation or sick leave and will not appear on the Putnam County payroll.
