that to provide for the unanticipated expenditures of said County during fiscal year ending December 31, 2026, the following sums be and the same are hereby transferred, set aside and appropriated for the purpose for which expenditures are to be made during the fiscal year as follows:

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Development allocated approximately \$2,000,000 for the PY2025 Ohio Small Cities Community and Economic Development Program, Flexible Grant Program, and

WHEREAS the CDBG Flexible Program provides communities with a means to fund worthwhile projects and qualify under the national objective of the elimination of slum and blight conditions, and

WHEREAS Putnam County held the first required public meeting for general CDBG Program funding on March 24, 2025, and held the second required program specific public meeting for CDBG Programs, including Flexible Grant Program, on February 9, 2026. This hearing provided citizens an opportunity to review and comment on the proposed projects before their submission to the Ohio Department of Development, Office of Community Development.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners, Putnam County, State of Ohio as follows:

SECTION 1. That the President is hereby authorized to file an application on behalf of the Village of Dupont for the PY2025 Ohio Small Cities Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), Flexible Grant Program as follows:

Activity 1:	Recreation Access/Building (CDBG Funds)	Up to \$40,000
TOTAL		Up to \$40,000

SECTION 2. This Board finds and determines that all formal actions of the Board concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Board and that all deliberations of this Board that resulted in those formal actions were in a meeting open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately after passage.

The landline calls are decreased due to people getting rid of their landlines. Tom Rampe was recognized for his retirement by this board also.

Tim Schnipke stopped in to talk to the Commissioners about the progress on the building inspections, new batteries are needed for the exit lights. Tim will be ordering a box of batteries for replacing. There are a large amount of exit lights in multiple buildings that will need to be replaced. Tim will try to order boxes of the lights as well for replacement.

Kim Rieman and Carrie Pessefall stopped in to introduce Carrie to the Commissioners as she is the new Public Information Officer for the Health department and the Office of Public Safety.

Kim said maintenance did an excellent job on rehabbing the reception area at the Health Dept. The door is still on order then the project will be completed. Kim shared an information packet from last night's board meeting.

Tim presented a quote for metal covering for the front of the Annex from Buckeye Fab for the covering. The previous covering was deteriorated and needed to be replaced. Glandorf has another sprinkler leaking in the attic. The leak was found in the airline and will be patched. John brought up the RFP about the change in the concrete for the bi-fold doors, when there is no concrete poured yet. A change to the outlets was also discussed. If there is no work done yet why is there a change order. Contractor meetings will be held monthly for the project, a state inspector will be present today, owner meetings will also be set up periodically throughout the project. The doorway that Brian wants added will be done so a door can be installed eventually. There are wires in the wall that need to be moved for the door opening.
